



## Syracuse University 2017-2018 InclusiveU Housing and Meal Plan Application

For the 2017-2018 Academic Year, Syracuse University will offer a limited number of on campus housing slots for InclusiveU students in the residence halls. Students will be housed along with first year students in specific Learning Communities. During this pilot year, students will choose from specific Learning Communities to join.

### FAQs:

#### **Q: What type of supports will students have available?**

**A:** A residential mentor, also an SU student, will live in the residence hall with the InclusiveU student, as their roommate, and will act as a specialized peer support who will help student organize their daily schedule, attend social activities with student and assist student in maintaining a safe living environment.

#### **Q: What are the costs for the residential mentor?**

**A:** The costs are approximately \$8,000 and can come out of the InclusiveU student's individualized self-direction budget through Medicaid Waiver if qualified. Brokers can use the LIC line.

#### **Q: What are the costs to live in the SU residence halls?**

**A:** Students will be responsible for SU Housing and Meal Plan costs.

**A:** Learning Communities are residential groups at Syracuse University designed to complement and enhance your educational experience at Syracuse University. Many students find that these special opportunities help ease the transition to college life, providing them with a group of peers and friends who become like a family away from home.
