Dear Student(s), Parent(s), Guardian(s) and Educators,

Thank you for your interest in the Syracuse City School District's OnCampus Program at Syracuse University. Enclosed, you will find a Student Application Form that will need to be submitted with two letters of recommendation to OnCampus Coordinator Yusuf Soule for consideration.

The OnCampus Program primarily follows the Syracuse University Academic Schedule and runs through the first Summer Session at SU. Students in the program begin the school year in late August and are off for 3-4 weeks in December/January.

Students frequently enter the program after four years of high school and must be registered in the SCSD. They must commit to be in the OnCampus program for 2-3 years or until the age of 21. Students in the program remain registered high school students and typically access ACCESS-VR services prior to their final year of the OnCampus Program.

If your son or daughter does not have a Service Coordinator, please contact Katherine to discuss this valuable support for student transition services beyond the OnCampus Program. Having a service coordinator while in the program improves the planning process for OnCampus students in preparation for life after their time at Syracuse University.

To be considered for the OnCampus Program:

1. Students must be between 18 and 21 years of age and be on track to receive a CDOS or SACC Diploma.
2. Students are expected to be in the OnCampus program for 2-3 years.
3. Students must have moderate to high-level support needs.
4. The OnCampus Program seeks to diversify its student composition (e.g. home school, gender, race, disability, etc.)
5. Parents/guardians must be supportive of their children's participation in the program.
6. Students must have a proven record of regular attendance in their highschools.
7. Students must submit two letters of recommendation from their teachers.
8. Students may be observed at their home schools after their applications are submitted.
9. Students must have an interview with one or all of the following people: Director(s); Dr. Soule; Ms. Teasdale-Edwards; an SU InclusiveU staff member.

The students admitted will be the ones who best meet the above guidelines and are best suited to the openings we have.
