<b>The George Jesien National Leadership Award</b> is named in honor of George Jesien, PhD, a long-time national leader in the disabilities field. In 2013 he retired from the position of executive director of the Association of University Centers on Disabilities. AUCD continues to be a guiding force that advances policy and practice for individuals with developmental and other disabilities as well as their families.
The Laura Lee Leadership Award is named in memory of Laura Lee, daughter of Gen and Stephanie Smith Lee, who was a pioneer in inclusive education at the national level. She passed away unexpectedly in 2016.
The Megan Cartier Early Scholars Award is given in honor of Megan Cartier, who passed away in

2023. Megan was a doctoral student whose support was pivotal in organizing the first Student

Leadership Conferences.
